In 2013, the Province of Manitoba announced the Accessibilities for Manitobans Act which requires all public sector organizations to develop and implement plans to enhance accessibility in five areas:

- Employment
- Information and Communications
- Built Environment
- Transportation

These standards give us a systematic guide by which to review current practices and consult with our community.

Guided by a team made up of the RM's Economic Development Officer, Recreation Director, two Councillors and one member of the L.U.D of Warren, phase one of this project is underway.
